•Before Chugach can begin construction your job site will need to be at final grade. Any clearing on your property that you have elected to do yourself needs to be completed prior to construction.

Payment to Chugach:

 Deliver payment, cash or check, to the Receptionist Desk of Chugach's offices at 5601 Electron Dr. when prompted by engineering.

Keep Communicating:

 Chugach can construct primary facilities to your lot when clearing is complete and your lot is at final grade. Contact your engineering representative when ready.

Municipal Inspection of Service Gear:

• When you've successfully passed inspection you will receive a green tag number.

Set Up Service Account:

Service Construction & Connect:

 Chugach may delay construction of the service run until your new service passes inspection. Crews will be scheduled once your green tag number is received. The service cannot be connected prior to municipal approval.
